A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 9 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to temporary assistance for needy families, so as to provide for general assistance
- 3 to qualified individuals; to provide for conditions, procedures, and limitations; to provide for
- 4 rules and regulations; to provide for administration; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 9 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 temporary assistance for needy families, is amended by adding a new Code section to read
- 10 as follows:

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- 11 "49-4-194.
- 12 (a) A person is eligible for general assistance who is financially needy, as determined in
- accordance with regulations promulgated under this Code section, does not qualify for
- 14 <u>federal supplemental security income payments, and:</u>
- 15 (1) Resides in a family which does not qualify for assistance under Article 8 of this title;
- 16 (2) Is an adult who does not reside with a dependent child; or

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17 (3) Is under the age of 18, not living with his or her child, and has no adult relatives with

- whom to reside.
- 19 (b) A person shall not be eligible for general assistance who has made a voluntary
- 20 <u>assignment or transfer of property for the purpose of qualifying for such aid.</u> A transfer of
- 21 property made within one year of the date of application shall be presumed to have been
- 22 <u>made for the purpose of qualifying for such assistance.</u>
- 23 (c) This Code section shall be administered by the department. The department shall issue
- 24 <u>such rules and regulations as may be necessary to administer this article, provided that such</u>
- 25 <u>state plan is administered within the appropriations made available to the department. Such</u>
- 26 <u>rules and regulations shall include, but shall not be limited to, providing:</u>
- 27 (1) Methods of administration necessary for the proper and efficient operation of the
- 28 <u>state plan for implementation of this Code section;</u>
- 29 (2) Reasonable standards for determining eligibility and the extent of assistance available
- 30 <u>for recipients; and</u>
- 31 (3) Consideration of the income and resources of an applicant for assistance in
- determining eligibility.
- 33 (d) Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this Code section, the department shall not issue
- 34 <u>rules and regulations establishing requirements for work activity, drug testing, or personal</u>
- 35 <u>responsibility."</u>

36 SECTION 2.

37 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
