A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 8 of Chapter 2 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

2 relating to the Office of Public Safety Support, so as to require such office to provide certain

3 language and disability accessibility services; to amend Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official

4 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions for professions and businesses,

5 so as to prohibit licensing boards from requiring applicants to pass an English proficiency

6 examination; to provide an exception; to amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the

7 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions for the Department of

Administrate Services, so as to require the department to assist citizens and local

governments with providing language, disability, and other accessibility services for any

state money grants, loans, contracts, or other potential sources of funding; to amend Code

Section 50-25-5.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to chief information

officer, appointment and removal, compensation, and powers and duties, so as to require

state websites to be accessible in languages other than English; to provide for related matters;

14 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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22 16 **SECTION 1.** 17 Article 8 of Chapter 2 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Office of Public Safety Support, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as 18 19 follows: 20 "35-2-165. 21 (a) The Office of Public Safety Support within the Department of Public Safety shall 22 provide support services regarding language, disability, and other accessibility to any 23 requesting public entities that employ public safety officers. 24 (b) The support coordinator provided for in this article, with approval of the commissioner, 25 may employ or retain persons as he or she deems necessary to serve as staff consistent with 26 the purposes of this article." 27 **SECTION 2.** 28 Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general 29 provisions for professions and businesses, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows: 30 31 "43-1-35. 32 Except as provided for in Code Section 43-26-61, no licensing board subject to this title 33 shall require any applicant for licensing to demonstrate the ability to speak, write, and 34 understand the English language solely through passage of an English proficiency 35 examination."

- 36 **SECTION 3.**
- 37 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 38 general provisions for the Department of Administrate Services, is amended by adding a new
- 39 Code section to read as follows:

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40 "50-5-18.

41 The Department of Administrative Services shall provide support to any resident of the 42 state who seeks assistance regarding language, disability, and other accessibility challenges to accessing any state money grants, loans, contracts, or other potential sources of funding 43 that are administered or offered by the department. The department shall also provide 44 support services to any unit of state government or any local political subdivisions or 45 authority that seek support regarding language, disability, and any other accessibility 46 47 challenges with respect to administration of grants, loans, contracts, or other potential sources of funding." 48

49 **SECTION 4.**

Code Section 50-25-5.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to chief information officer, appointment and removal, compensation, and powers and duties, is

amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (b) to read as follows:

53 "(6.1) To ensure that all websites operated or maintained by the state government are 54 accessible in languages other than English and to persons with disabilities;"

55 SECTION 5.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
