A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 10-1-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	unlawful unfair or deceptive practices in consumer transactions, so as to classify the failure
3	to provide a warning that a license plate frame or mounting device may violate state law as
4	an unfair or deceptive practice; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5	for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Code Section 10-1-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to unlawful
9	unfair or deceptive practices in consumer transactions, is amended in subsection (b) by
10	deleting "and" at the end of division (33)(B)(iii), by replacing the period with "; and" at the
11	end of paragraph (34), and by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
12	"(35) Failure of the seller of any frame or device for use in mounting a license plate upon
13	a motor vehicle to provide in writing a warning that use of such item may violate state
14	law. For purposes of this paragraph, the term 'seller' shall include any person who
15	provides another with such a frame or device, regardless of whether the item is
16	exchanged for any valuable consideration."

SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
