The House Committee on Motor Vehicles offers the following substitute to HB 174:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- To amend Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 1
- 2 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, so as to provide for the
- 3 proper display of license plates; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 5

6 **SECTION 1.**

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, is amended by revising Code Section
- 9 40-2-41, relating to display of license plates, as follows:
- "40-2-41. 10

- Unless otherwise permitted under this chapter, every vehicle required to be registered under 11
- 12 this chapter, which is in use upon the highways, shall at all times display the license plate
- issued to the owner for such vehicle, and the plate shall be fastened to the rear of the 13
- 14 vehicle in a position so as not to swing and shall be at all times plainly visible. Such
- 15 license plate shall not be obstructed in any way that prevents the alphanumeric designation
- and revalidation decal from being readily identifiable. No person shall display on the rear 16
- of a motor vehicle any temporary or permanent plate or tag not issued by the State of 18 Georgia which is intended to resemble a license plate which is issued by the State of
- 19 Georgia. The commissioner is authorized to adopt rules and regulations so as to permit the
- 20 display of a license plate on the front of certain vehicles. It shall be the duty of the operator
- 21 of any vehicle to keep the license plate legible at all times. No license plate shall be
- 22 covered with any material unless the material is colorless and transparent. No apparatus
- 23 that obstructs or hinders the clear display and legibility of a license plate shall be attached
- 24 to the rear of any motor vehicle required to be registered in the state. Any person who
- 25 violates any provision of this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

26 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 27
