A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia
 Annotated, relating to general provisions regarding state sales and use taxes, so as to change

3 the exemption from such taxes for certain jet fuel; to provide for related matters; to provide

4 for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
relating to general provisions regarding state sales and use taxes, is amended by revising
subparagraph (E) of paragraph (33.1) of Code Section 48-8-3, relating to exemptions from
state sales and use taxes, as follows:

11 "(E) For purposes of division (ii) of subparagraph (B) of this paragraph and paragraph 12 (2) of subsection (d) of Code Section 48-8-241, a 'qualifying airline' shall mean any 13 person which is authorized by the Federal Aviation Administration or appropriate 14 agency of the United States to operate as an air carrier under an air carrier operating 15 certificate and which provides regularly scheduled flights for the transportation of 16 passengers or cargo for hire and which had an aggregate state sales and use tax liability 17 for the immediately preceding taxable year of \$15 million or less."

SECTION 2.
