To amend Chapter 1 of Title 7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
financial institutions, so as to provide a definition; to prohibit the use of EBT cards in
automated teller machines to obtain cash; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
laws; and for other purposes.

- 11 (a) As used in this article, the term 'electronic benefit transfer card' means a card that
- 12 provides public assistance benefits under Chapter 4 of Title 49 or other programs, including
- 13 the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program or food stamp program, through an
- 14 <u>electronic benefit transfer service.</u>
- 15 (b) No bank or other merchant in this state offering automated teller machine services shall
- 16 <u>allow such automated teller machines to accept or persons to use electronic benefit transfer</u>
- 17 cards to obtain cash from such machines."

- 19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
