A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 4 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to horns, exhaust systems, mirrors, windshields, tires, safety belts, and
- 3 energy absorption systems, so as to provide for a definition relating to excessive and unusual
- 4 noise of a motor vehicle muffler; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective
- 5 date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 4 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to horns, exhaust systems, mirrors, windshields, tires, safety belts, and energy
- absorption systems, is amended by revising Code Section 40-8-71, relating to exhaust system
- and prevention of noise, smoke, and fumes, as follows:

- 13 (a) Every motor vehicle shall at all times be equipped with an exhaust system, in good
- working order and in constant operation, meeting the following specifications:
- 15 (1) The exhaust system shall include the piping leading from the flange of the exhaust
- manifold to and including the muffler or mufflers and tail pipes;

17 (2) The use of flexible pipe shall be prohibited except on diesel tractors or according to manufacturers' original specifications;

- 19 (3) The exhaust emission point shall extend beyond the rear or outside of the passenger
- compartment. The trunk shall be considered as part of the passenger compartment;
- 21 (4) The exhaust system and its elements shall be securely fastened, including the
- consideration of missing or broken hangers; and
- 23 (5) There shall be no part of the exhaust system passing through the passenger
- compartment or any exposed stack so located that any individual entering or leaving the
- vehicle may be burned.
- 26 (b) The engine and power mechanism of every motor vehicle shall be so equipped and
- adjusted as to prevent the escape of excessive fumes or smoke.
- 28 (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer for sale any muffler which causes
- 29 excessive or unusual noise or annoying smoke or any muffler cutout, bypass, or similar
- device for use on a motor vehicle or for any person to use operate, to sell, or to offer for
- 31 sale any motor vehicle equipped with any such muffler, muffler cutout, bypass, or similar
- device. For purposes of this subsection, the term 'excessive or unusual noise' means any
- sound greater than 95 decibels when such noise is produced by a motor vehicle other than
- 34 <u>a motorcycle.</u> Any person violating this subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

35 SECTION 2.

- This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021, and shall apply to offenses committed on
- 37 or after that date.

38 SECTION 3.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
