The Senate Committee on Higher Education offered the following substitute to HB 185:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 postsecondary education, so as to require the university system to provide quarterly reports
- 3 regarding certain funding received from foreign adversaries and certain individuals or entities
- 4 related to foreign adversaries; to provide for definitions; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 7 SECTION 1.
- 8 Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to postsecondary
- 9 education, is amended by revising Code Section 20-3-84, which is designated as reserved,
- 10 as follows:
- 11 "20-3-84.
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 13 (1) 'Foreign adversary' means:
- 14 (A) People's Republic of China, including the Hong Kong Special Administrative
- Region (China);
- 16 (B) Republic of Cuba (Cuba);

- 17 (C) Islamic Republic of Iran (Iran);
- (D) Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea);
- (E) Russian Federation (Russia); or
- 20 (F) Venezuelan politician Nicolás Maduro (Maduro Regime).
- 21 (2) 'Foreign entity of concern' means any organization, institution of higher education,
- 22 <u>association, corporation, or other entity organized under the laws of, or having its</u>
- principal place of business in, any country listed in subparagraphs (A) through (E) of
- 24 paragraph (1) of this subsection, or any subsidiary of any such entity.
- 25 (3) 'Foreign individual of concern' means any individual who is domiciled in any country
- 26 <u>listed in subparagraphs (A) through (E) of paragraph (1) of this subsection and who is not</u>
- a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States.
- 28 (4) 'Funding' means any gift, grant, donation, payment in exchange for services, capital
- 29 <u>investment, salary, wage, compensation, fee, or other monetary exchange.</u>
- 30 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this Code section, the university system shall
- 31 provide on the first day of each calendar quarter to the Governor, the chairperson of the
- 32 House Committee on Higher Education, and the chairperson of the Senate Higher
- 33 Education Committee a report detailing all funding received by the university system from
- 34 <u>a foreign adversary, a foreign entity of concern, or a foreign individual of concern during</u>
- 35 the prior calendar quarter. Such report shall include:
- 36 (1) The amount of funding received;
- 37 (2) The type of funding, whether a gift, grant, donation, payment in exchange for
- 38 services, capital investment, salary, wage, compensation, or fee;
- 39 (3) A detailed description of the government, entity, or individual providing the funding,
- 40 <u>including the name and address of such government, entity, or individual;</u>
- 41 (4) A copy of any contract, agreement, or memorandum of understanding associated with

43 (5) Details regarding the purpose of the funding and indicating whether the funding was

- 44 <u>a one-time event or part of a series of funding events.</u>
- 45 (c) This Code section shall not require reporting of funding provided by an individual or
- 46 <u>a family as payment for tuition or related fees for a student or students affiliated with or</u>
- 47 <u>attending a University System of Georgia program, class, or course of study.</u> Reserved."

49 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
