# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 27-3-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to seasons and bag limits, promulgation of rules and regulations by the board, possession of more than bag limit, and reporting number of deer killed, so as to change certain provisions relating to open seasons for the hunting of deer; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

41	"(c) In accordance with subsection (b) of this Code section and as may be appropriate,		
42	based on sound wildlife management principles, the board is authorized to promulgate rules		
43	and regulations establishing open seasons on a state-wide, regional, or local basis and		
44	establishing daily and season bag limits; provided, however, that the closing date of the		
45	open season for hunting deer with firearms shall be uniform statewide."
