

House Bill 198

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-6-10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 insurance requirements for operation of motor vehicles generally, so as to expand the time
3 for alternate acceptable proof of insurance; to permit as temporary acceptable proof of
4 insurance a current written binder for coverage under certain conditions; to provide for
5 related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 40-6-10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance
10 requirements for operation of motor vehicles generally, is amended by revising
11 subparagraph (a)(2)(A) as follows:

12 "(A) If the policy providing such coverage was applied for within the last 30 days or
13 within 30 days of the expiration of a temporary operating permit on such vehicle, a
14 current written binder for such coverage for a period not exceeding 30 days from the
15 date such binder was issued or 30 days from the expiration of an extended temporary

16 operating permit on such vehicle shall be considered satisfactory proof or evidence of
17 required minimum insurance coverage;"

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
20 without such approval.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
