## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 9-3-33.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 actions for childhood sexual abuse, so as to change provisions relating to the revival of
- 3 certain claims; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 9-3-33.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to actions for
- 8 childhood sexual abuse, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 9 "(d)(1) For a period of two four years following July 1, 2015, plaintiffs of any age who
- were time barred from filing a civil action for injuries resulting from childhood sexual
- abuse due to the expiration of the statute of limitations in effect on June 30, 2015, shall
- be permitted to file such actions against the individual alleged to have committed such
- abuse before July 1, <del>2017</del> <u>2019</u>, thereby reviving those civil actions which had lapsed or
- technically expired under the law in effect on June 30, 2015.
- 15 (2) The revival of a claim as provided in paragraph (1) of this subsection shall not apply
- 16 to:

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- 17 (A) Any claim that has been litigated to finality on the merits in a court of competent
- jurisdiction prior to July 1, 2015 2017. Termination of a prior civil action on the basis
- of the expiration of the statute of limitations shall not constitute a claim that has been
- 20 litigated to finality on the merits;
- 21 (B) Any written settlement agreement which has been entered into between a plaintiff
- and a defendant when the plaintiff was represented by an attorney who was admitted
- 23 to practice law in this state at the time of the settlement, and the plaintiff signed such
- agreement; and
- (C) Any claim against an entity, as such term is defined in subsection (c) of this Code
- section.

28 SECTION 2.

- 29 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 30 without such approval.

31 SECTION 3.

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
