A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-7-40	1.16 of the	Official Co	oae or (jeorgia <i>i</i>	Annotatea,	relating to
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- 2 an income tax credit for low-emission vehicles, so as to change the amount of the credit for
- 3 electric vehicle chargers; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-7-40.16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to an income
- 8 tax credit for low-emission vehicles, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 9 "(d) A tax credit is allowed against the tax imposed under this article to any business
- 10 enterprise engaged in the ownership or operation of commercial office, residential, retail,
- or industrial real property for the purchase or lease of each electric vehicle charger that is
- located in the State of Georgia. The amount of the credit shall be:
- 13 (1) Twenty 10 percent of the cost of the charger or \$2,500.00, whichever is less, until
- 14 June 30, 2018; and
- 15 (2) Ten percent of the cost of the charger or \$2,500.00, whichever is less, from July 1,
- 16 <u>2018, until June 30, 2020.</u>
- 17 The total amount of income tax credits under this subsection shall not exceed \$750,000.00
- in any given year."

19 SECTION 2.

20 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015.

21 SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
