A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to provide a sales tax exemption for materials to
3 be used in certain construction projects of zoological institutions; to provide for an effective
4 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
8 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising paragraph (87) as follows:

9 "(87)(A) Notwithstanding any provision of Code Section 48-8-63 to the contrary, from
10 July 1, ~~2009~~ 2013, until June 30, ~~2011~~ 2015, sales of tangible personal property used
11 for and in the renovation or expansion of a zoological institution.

12 (B) As used in this paragraph, the term 'zoological institution' means a nonprofit
13 wildlife park, terrestrial institution, or facility which is:

14 (i) ~~Open~~ Is open to the public, ~~that~~ exhibits and cares for a collection consisting
15 primarily of animals other than fish, and has received accreditation from the
16 Association of Zoos and Aquariums; and

17 (ii) ~~Located~~ Is located in this state and owned or operated by an organization which
18 is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

19 (C) Any person making a sale of tangible personal property for the purpose specified
20 in this paragraph shall collect the tax imposed on this sale unless the purchaser
21 furnishes such person with an exemption determination letter issued by the
22 commissioner certifying that the purchaser is entitled to purchase the tangible personal
23 property without paying the tax;"

25 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013.

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SECTION 3.

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
