A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions relative to uniform rules of the road, so as to provide for
- 3 procedure for passing sanitation vehicles; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 general provisions relative to uniform rules of the road, is amended by adding a new Code
- 9 section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>40-6-16.1.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'sanitation worker' means an individual engaged
- in the collection and transport of residential or commercial solid waste and recyclables as
- authorized by a county or municipal governing authority.
- 14 (b) The operator of a motor vehicle approaching a vehicle with active sanitation workers
- that is displaying flashing yellow, amber, white, or red lights shall approach the vehicle
- with due caution and shall, absent any other direction by a peace officer, proceed as
- 17 <u>follows:</u>
- 18 (1) Make a lane change into a lane not adjacent to the vehicle if possible in the existing
- 19 <u>safety and traffic conditions; or</u>
- 20 (2) If a lane change under paragraph (1) of this subsection would be impossible,
- 21 prohibited by law, or unsafe, reduce the speed of the motor vehicle to a reasonable and
- 22 proper speed for the existing road and traffic conditions, which speed shall be at least ten
- 23 <u>miles per hour less than the posted speed limit, and be prepared to stop.</u>
- 24 (c) Violation of subsection (b) of this Code section shall be punished by a fine of not more
- 25 than \$500.00."
