## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to exempt the sale or use of certain absorbent
- 3 diapers, undergarments, and pads from taxation; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 8 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising paragraph (58) as follows:
- 9 "(58) The sale or use of any absorbent diaper, undergarment, or pads primarily designed
- 10 <u>to be worn by either a child who cannot control their bladder or bowel movements or an</u>
- 11 <u>adult who experiences incontinence</u> Reserved;"

12 SECTION 2.

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
