A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 Code Section 19-6-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to child support
- 2 in final verdict or decree, so as to enact a recommendation by the Georgia Child Support
- 3 Commission relating to child support; to change provisions relating to work related child care
- 4 costs; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Code Section 19-6-15, relating to child support in final verdict or decree, is amended by 8 revising subparagraph (h)(1)(F) of as follows: 9 "(F)(i) The total amount of work related child care costs shall be divided between the 10 parents pro rata to determine the presumptive amount of child support and shall be 11 included in the worksheet and written order of the court the final child support order. 12 (ii) In situations in which work related child care costs may be variable, the court or 13 jury may, in its discretion, remove work related child care costs from the calculation 14 of support, and divide the work related child care costs pro rata, to be paid within a 15 time specified in the final child support order. If a parent or nonparent custodian fails 16 to comply with the final child support order: 17 (I) The other parent or nonparent custodian may enforce payment of the work related child care costs by any means permitted by law; or 18 19 (II) Child support services shall pursue enforcement when such unpaid costs have 20 been reduced to a judgment in a sum certain."

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
