A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the 2 Department of Community Health, so as to provide for annual quality and payment reporting 3 for health care plans and programs administered by the department; to amend Article 7 of 4 Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to medical 5 assistance generally, so as to include comprehensive dental and vision coverage under Medicaid for adults; to increase Medicaid reimbursement rates for primary care services; to 6 7 provide for the submission of a state plan amendment or waiver, if necessary; to provide for 8 related matters; to provide for contingent effectiveness; to repeal conflicting laws; and for 9 other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

11	SECTION 1.
12	Chapter 2 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department
13	of Community Health, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
14	″ <u>31-2-17.</u>
15	(a) The department shall provide an annual report on quality measures for each health care
16	plan or program administered by or through the department, including, but not limited to:

17	(1) The state health benefit plan administered pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title
18	<u>45;</u>
19	(2) The plan for public school teachers and employees administered pursuant to Part 6
20	of Article 17 of Chapter 2 of Title 20;
21	(3) The medical assistance program administered pursuant to Article 7 of Chapter 4 of
22	Title 49, including the Medicaid fee-for-service program and Medicaid care management
23	organizations; and
24	(4) The PeachCare for Kids Program administered pursuant to Article 13 of Chapter 5
25	of Title 49.
26	(b) Such annual report shall be made publicly available and shall include, at a minimum,
27	quality measures and payment levels across key medical billing codes for each health care
28	plan or program administered by the department."
29	SECTION 2.
30	Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
31	medical assistance generally, is amended by adding new Code sections to read as follows:
32	″ <u>49-4-159.1.</u>
33	(a) On and after January 1, 2022, medical assistance under this article shall include
34	comprehensive dental and vision coverage for adults at no additional premium.
35	Comprehensive dental coverage shall include emergency services, exams, preventive
36	services, basic restorative services, advanced restorative services, periodontal services, and
37	oral surgery services. Comprehensive vision coverage shall include eye exams, eyeglass
38	frames, prescription eyeglass lenses, bifocals or trifocals, contact lenses if medically
39	necessary, medical and surgical procedures, and screenings for glaucoma.
40	(b) The department shall submit a Medicaid state plan amendment, if necessary to
41	implement the provisions of this Code section, to the United States Department of Health
42	and Human Services.

- 44 (a) Effective July 1, 2021, the reimbursement rates for primary care services provided to
- 45 recipients of medical assistance shall be equal to the applicable Medicare allowable rates
- 46 <u>applicable to the 2020 calendar year, as adopted by the federal Centers for Medicare and</u>
- 47 <u>Medicaid Services.</u>
- 48 (b) The department shall submit a Medicaid state plan amendment, if necessary to
- 49 <u>implement the provisions of this Code section, to the United States Department of Health</u>
- 50 and Human Services."
