A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 3 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to income tax returns and furnishing of information, so as to authorize the state revenue commissioner to require by rule and regulation for individual income tax returns, reports, and other documents to be filed electronically; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Article 3 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 9 income tax returns and furnishing of information, is amended by revising Code Section
 10 48-7-55, which was previously reserved, as follows:
- 11 ″48-7-55.

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- 12 (a) With respect to individual income tax returns, the commissioner is authorized to
- 13 require any return, report, or other document that is required by this chapter to be filed
- 14 <u>electronically with the commissioner by or on behalf of an individual.</u>
- 15 (b) The commissioner is authorized to establish a process for individuals and tax preparers
- 16 to receive a waiver from the electronic filing requirement described in subsection (a) of this
- 17 <u>Code section.</u>
- 18 (c) The commissioner shall be authorized to adopt such rules and regulations as are
- 19 reasonable and necessary to provide for the means, form, and manner in which to effectuate
- 20 this Code section. Reserved."
