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The House Committee on Public Health offers the following substitute to HB 226:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to medical assistance generally, so as to require the Department of Community
- 3 Health to submit a Section 1115 waiver request to the federal Centers for Medicare and
- 4 Medicaid Services for a demonstration project to provide treatment services under Medicaid
- 5 to persons in this state living with HIV; to provide for implementation upon approval; to
- 6 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 medical assistance generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "49-4-142.6.

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- 12 (a) On or before December 31, 2023, the department shall submit a waiver request to the
- 13 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the United States Department of Health and
- Human Services pursuant to Section 1115 of the federal Social Security Act to conduct a
- demonstration project to provide treatment services under Medicaid to persons in this state
- living with human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). Such demonstration project shall be

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- designed to provide more effective, early treatment of HIV to persons in this state by
- making available a package of services, including antiretrovirals. The eligibility criteria
- 19 <u>for recipients shall include having a diagnosis of HIV, an income of less than 100 percent</u>
- 20 <u>of the federal poverty level, and no health insurance.</u>
- 21 (b) Upon approval of the waiver, the department shall take all necessary steps to
- implement the terms and conditions of the waiver."
- 23 SECTION 2.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
