A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to searches with warrants, so as to prohibit the use of no-knock search warrants; to
- 3 provide for definitions; to change provisions relating to the issuance of search warrants; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 searches with warrants, is amended in Code Section 17-5-21, relating to grounds for issuance
- 10 of search warrants and scope of search pursuant to a search warrant, by adding a new
- 11 subsection to read as follows:

- 12 "(e)(1) As used in this subsection, the term 'no-knock provision' means a provision in a
- search warrant that authorizes the executing officer to enter without giving audible.
- verbal notice of such officer's presence, authority, and purpose.
- 15 (2) No search warrant shall be issued which contains a no-knock provision."

16 SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval and shall apply to all search warrants issued on or after such date.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
