## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	definitions relative to HOPE scholarships and grants, so as to provide that spouses and
3	dependent children of military service members and veterans are eligible as Zell Miller Grant
4	Scholars; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
8	relative to HOPE scholarships and grants, is amended by revising paragraph (26.1) as
9	follows:
10	"(26.1) 'Zell Miller Grant Scholar' means a student that who has met the applicable
11	eligibility requirements to receive a HOPE grant in accordance with Code Section
12	20-3-519.5 and:
13	(A) Earned earned a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 at the end of any
14	quarter or semester in which the student has attended courses toward a diploma or
15	certificate <u>; or</u>
16	(B)(i) Is the spouse or dependent child of an active duty military service member who
17	is stationed in Georgia or who is on deployment and lists Georgia as such service
18	member's home of record; or
19	(ii) Is a veteran of any branch of the armed services of the United States and resides
20	<u>in Georgia</u> ."
21	SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
