A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to general authority, duties, and procedure relative to state purchasing,
- 3 so as to require equal credits be given to certain forestry certification systems when using
- 4 green building standards in state construction, operation, repair, and renovation projects; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to general authority, duties, and procedure relative to state purchasing, is amended
- by revising Code Section 50-5-63, relating to the exclusive use of Georgia forest products
- in state construction contracts, as follows:
- 13 "50-5-63.
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Green building standards' means any system or tool created to rate the environmental
- efficiency and sustainability of the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of
- 17 <u>a building.</u>
- 18 (2) 'State building' means any facility owned, constructed, or acquired by the State of
- 19 Georgia or any department, board, commission, or agency thereof, including state
- 20 <u>supported institutions of higher learning.</u>
- 21 (a)(b) No contract for the construction of, addition to, or repair or renovation of any
- facility, the cost of which is borne by the this state or any department, agency, commission,
- authority, or political subdivision thereof, shall be let unless the contract contains a
- stipulation therein providing that the contractor or any subcontractor shall use exclusively
- 25 Georgia forest products in the construction thereof, when forest products are to be used in

- 28 (c) Whenever green building standards are applied to the new construction, operation,
- 29 repair, or renovation of any state building, the state shall use only those green building
- 30 standards that give certification credits equally to Georgia forest products grown,
- 31 <u>manufactured</u>, and certified under the Sustainable Forestry Initiative, the American Tree
- 32 <u>Farm System, and the Forest Stewardship Council.</u>
- 33 (b)(d) This Code section shall not apply when in conflict with federal rules and regulations
- 34 concerning construction."
- 35 SECTION 2.
- 36 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015, and shall apply to all contracts entered into
- on or after such date.
- 38 SECTION 3.
- 39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
