- 12 "(f) When the alleged victim is under the age of 16 years and the conduct is for the purpose
- of sexual arousal on the part of the alleged offender or alleged victim, consent of the
- alleged victim shall not be a defense to a prosecution under this Code section."

- 17 battery, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

- 19 purpose of sexual arousal on the part of the alleged offender or alleged victim, consent of
- 20 the alleged victim shall not be a defense to a prosecution under this Code section."
