A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections and primaries generally, so as to provide that persons who register to vote by mail
- 3 shall vote for the first time in person; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
- 8 primaries generally, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code
- 9 Section 21-2-381, relating to making of application for absentee ballot, determination of
- 10 eligibility by ballot clerk, furnishing of applications to colleges and universities, and persons
- 11 entitled to make application, by adding a new subparagraph to read as follows:
- 12 "(H) An elector who registers to vote in this state by mail shall not be entitled to vote
- by absentee ballot unless such elector:
- (i) Has voted in person previously in this state;
- 15 (ii) Is entitled to vote by absentee ballot under the federal Uniformed and Overseas
- 16 <u>Citizens Absentee Voting Act, 52 U.S.C. Chapter 203;</u>

- 17 (iii) Is 65 years of age or older; or
- 18 (iv) Is physically disabled."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
