A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions relating to health, so as to require certain notice in a
- 3 mammogram report to patients with dense breast tissue; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 general provisions relating to health, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "31-1-14.
- A health care facility at which a mammography examination is performed shall, if a patient
- is categorized by the facility as having heterogeneously dense breasts or extremely dense
- breasts, based on the Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System established by the
- 14 American College of Radiology, include in the summary of the written report that is sent
- to the patient, as required by federal law, the following notice:
- 16 <u>Your mammogram indicates that you have dense breast tissue. Dense breast tissue is</u>
- 17 <u>relatively common and is found in 40 percent of women. The presence of dense tissue</u>
- makes it more difficult to detect cancers in the breast by mammography and may be
- 19 <u>associated with an increased risk of breast cancer. We are providing this information to</u>
- 20 <u>raise your awareness of this important factor and to encourage you to discuss with your</u>
- 21 <u>health care providers your dense breast tissue and other breast cancer risk factors.</u>
- 22 Together, you can decide which screening options are right for you. A report of your
- 23 results was sent to your physician.'"

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
