## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 special license plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit
- 3 corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit
- 4 corporation, so as to establish a specialty license plate honoring the Georgia Council on
- 5 Substance Abuse, Inc., and the Georgia Mental Health Consumer Network, Inc.; to provide
- 6 for related matters; to provide for compliance with constitutional requirements; to repeal
- 7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
- 11 plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations with
- 12 proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation, is
- amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:
- 14 "(58) A special license plate honoring the Georgia Council on Substance Abuse, Inc., and
- the Georgia Mental Health Consumer Network, Inc. The funds raised by the sale of this
- special license plate shall be disbursed equally to the Georgia Council on Substance
- Abuse, Inc., and the Georgia Mental Health Consumer Network, Inc. Such license plate
- shall not include a space for a county name decal but shall instead bear the legend
- 19 <u>'Georgia Recovers' in lieu of the name of the county of issuance."</u>

SECTION 2.

- 21 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
- 22 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
- 23 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.
