## House Bill 348 By: Representative Martin of the 49<sup>th</sup>

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Article 2 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2	relating to leaves of absences for certain public employees, so as to authorize the application
3	for limited paid leave for the purpose of volunteering and providing nonprofit support in this
4	state; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Article 2 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8	leaves of absences for certain public employees, is amended by adding a new Code section
9	to read as follows:
10	″ <u>45-20-33.</u>
11	Each full-time, nontemporary employee of the State of Georgia or of any branch,
12	department, board, bureau, or commission thereof shall be entitled to apply for up to eight
13	hours of paid leave per calendar year for the purpose of volunteering in this state. The
14	State Personnel Board shall submit to the Governor for approval rules and regulations
15	which shall effectuate the purpose and govern the administration of this Code section.
16	Such rules and regulations shall require that paid leave only be authorized for activities
17	directly related to volunteering and providing nonprofit support and shall prohibit the use
18	of such leave for political purposes or agendas. For the purposes of this Code section,
19	volunteering may only be performed with an organization recognized under Section
20	501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code."
21	SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
