The Senate Committee on Health and Human Services offered the following substitute to HB 382:

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 5 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
relating to the Georgia Commission on Women, so as to place said commission under the
administration of the Department of Public Health; to provide for related matters; to provide

4 for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## **SECTION 1.** 6 7 Article 5 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the 8 Georgia Commission on Women, is amended in Code Section 50-12-80, relating to creation 9 of the commission, appointments to and vacancies in membership, and staggered terms, by 10 adding a new subsection to read as follows: 11 "(d) The commission shall be assigned to the Department of Public Health for 12 administrative purposes only, as prescribed in Code Section 50-4-3." 13 **SECTION 2.** 14 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 15 without such approval. 16 **SECTION 3.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
