A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act providing a new charter for the City of Warner Robins in Houston County,
- 2 approved March 7, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978, p. 3081), as amended, so as to revise the
- 3 qualifications for candidates for mayor and council; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act providing a new charter for the City of Warner Robins in Houston County, approved
- 8 March 7, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978, p. 3081), as amended, is amended by revising Section 2-102 as
- 9 follows:

- 10 "Section 2-102. Qualifications. (a) In order to be eligible for election or appointment to
- a post on the city council, a person shall have attained the age of 21 and have resided in the
- 12 city for a period of one year, and with respect to members of the council representing
- council districts, shall have resided in the council district for a period of six months. Such
- residency requirements shall be calculated from the date of qualifying for election or
- appointment.
- 16 (b) In order to be eligible for election or appointment to the office of mayor, a person shall
- have attained the age of 23 and have resided in the city for a period of one year. Such
- 18 residency requirement shall be calculated from the date of qualifying for election or
- 19 appointment."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
