A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the imposition, rate, computation, and exemptions from state income tax, so as to
- 3 allow for a deduction for child support payments made pursuant to a court order to a
- 4 custodial parent under certain circumstances; to provide for rules and regulations; to provide
- 5 for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting
- 6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 10 imposition, rate, computation, and exemptions from state income tax, is amended by adding
- 11 a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>48-7-26.1.</u>
- 13 (a) For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2019, an exemption shall be allowed
- 14 as a deduction in computing the Georgia taxable net income of an individual in the amount
- of his or her payments made pursuant to a child support order to the custodial parent or
- \$3,000.00, whichever is less, provided that he or she is not in arrears for child support
- 17 payments required pursuant to any child support order.
- 18 (b) The commissioner shall be authorized to promulgate rules and regulations necessary
- 19 <u>to implement this Code section.</u>"
- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019, and shall be applicable to all taxable years
- beginning on or after January 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
