## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 35-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 acquisition, collection, classification, and preservation of information assisting in identifying
- 3 deceased persons and locating missing persons, so as to provide for the immediate opening
- of investigations of missing veterans and service members who have physical or mental 4
- 5 injuries arising from their service; to amend Code Section 35-3-172 of the Official Code of
- Georgia Annotated, relating to development and implementation of a state-wide alert system 6
- 7 for disabled adults and medically endangered persons, so as to include in such alert system
- missing veterans and service members who have physical or mental injuries arising from 8
- 9 their service; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.** 12

- Code Section 35-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to acquisition, 13
- 14 collection, classification, and preservation of information assisting in identifying deceased
- 15 persons and locating missing persons, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- "(c) Any law enforcement agency which receives a report that a person who has 16
- 17 Alzheimer's disease or other mental illness involving dementia, or is a veteran or active
- duty member of the regular, reserve, or National Guard component of the United States 18
- 19 armed forces or the United States Coast Guard who is believed to have a physical or mental
- 20 health condition that is related to his or her service is missing shall immediately open an
- investigation for the purpose of determining such person's whereabouts; and no policy for 22 applying any waiting period prior to initiation of a missing persons investigation shall
- apply in the case of such a person who has Alzheimer's disease or other mental illnesses 23
- 24 involving dementia."

Code Section 35-3-172 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to development and implementation of a state-wide alert system for disabled adults and medically endangered persons, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:

"(a) With the cooperation of the office of the Governor, the Georgia Lottery Corporation, and other appropriate law enforcement agencies in this state, the bureau shall develop and implement a state-wide alert system to be activated on behalf of missing disabled adults, and medically endangered persons, and veterans or active duty members of the regular, reserve, or National Guard component of the United States armed forces or the United States Coast Guard who are believed to have a physical or mental health condition that is

35 related to their service."
