## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to health of elementary and secondary school students, so as to require public schools and local school systems to provide water safety education information upon initial enrollment to parents and guardians of students under 18 years of age and directly to student 18 years of age and older; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## **SECTION 1.**

9 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

10 relating to health of elementary and secondary school students, is amended by adding a new

- 12 <u>"20-2-779.3.</u>
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'water safety education' means education
- 14 intended to promote safety in, on, and around bodies of water and reduce the risk of injury
- 15 <u>or drowning.</u>

16	(b) Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, each public school or local school system
17	shall provide the parents and guardians of each child initially enrolled in such school or
18	school system with information on the important role water safety education courses and
19	swimming lessons play in saving lives. Such information shall be provided in electronic
20	or hard copy format and shall include options for age-appropriate water safety education
21	courses and swimming lessons that can result in a certificate indicating successful
22	completion, including courses and lessons offered for free or at a reduced price; provided,
23	however, that such information shall be provided directly to students 18 years of age and
24	<u>older."</u>
