BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Chapter 6 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to interstate 8 cooperation, is amended in Code Section 28-6-1, relating to the creation of Senate, House, 9 and Governor's committees on interstate cooperation and membership, by revising 10 subsections (a) and (b) as follows: 11 "(a) There is established a standing committee of the Senate of this state to be known 12 officially as the Senate Committee on Interstate Cooperation Committee and to consist of 13 at least five Senators. The members and the chairman of this committee shall be 14 designated in the same manner as is customary in the case of the members and chairmen 15 of other standing committees of the Senate. In addition to the regular members, the 16 President of the Senate shall be ex officio an honorary nonvoting member of this

(b) There is established a standing committee of the House of Representatives of this state 18 to be known officially as the House Committee on Interstate Cooperation and to consist of 19 at least five members of the House of Representatives. The members and the chairman of 20 21 this committee shall be designated in the same manner as is customary in the case of the 22 members and chairmen of other standing committees of the House of Representatives. In addition to the regular members, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be ex 23 24 officio an honorary nonvoting member of this committee."
