A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics
- 2 in government, so as to revise what public officers may receive for participation in certain
- 3 activities; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics in
- 7 government, is amended by revising Code Section 21-5-11, relating to acceptance by public
- 8 officers of monetary fees or honoraria, as follows:
- 9 "21-5-11.
- 10 (a) No public officer other than a public officer elected state wide shall accept a monetary
- 11 fee or honorarium other valuable consideration in excess of \$100.00 for a speaking
- 12 engagement, participation in a seminar, discussion panel, or other activity which directly
- relates to the official duties of that public officer or the office of that public officer.
- 14 (b) No public officer elected state wide shall accept any monetary fee or honorarium other
- 15 <u>valuable consideration</u> for a speaking engagement, participation in a seminar, discussion
- panel, or other such activity.
- 17 (c) For purposes of this chapter, actual and reasonable expenses for food, beverages,
- travel, lodging, and registration for a meeting which are provided to permit participation
- in a panel or speaking engagement at the meeting shall not be monetary fees or honoraria
- 20 <u>other valuable consideration."</u>

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
