A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
 relating to landlord and tenant in general, so as to provide that conditioned air is a utility a

3 landlord cannot knowingly and willfully suspend; to provide for related matters; to repeal

4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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SECTION 1.

7 Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 landlord and tenant in general, is amended by revising Code Section 44-7-14.1, relating to
9 landlord's duties as to utilities, as follows:

10 "44-7-14.1.

(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'utilities' means <u>conditioned air</u>, heat, light, and
water service.

13 (b) It shall be unlawful for any landlord knowingly and willfully to suspend the furnishing

14 of utilities to a tenant until after the final disposition of any dispossessory proceeding by

15 the landlord against such tenant.

- 16 (c) Any person who violates subsection (b) of this Code section shall, upon conviction, be
- 17 assessed a fine not to exceed \$500.00."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
