## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to settlement of boundary disputes, so as to provide that, in cases of boundary
- 3 disputes between two or more counties, all ad valorem property taxes and sales and use taxes
- 4 levied on and collected from the area in dispute shall be paid into an escrow account pending
- 5 resolution of such dispute; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to
- 6 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 settlement of boundary disputes, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 <u>"36-3-28.</u>
- During the pendency of a dispute between two or more counties regarding the boundary
- line between such counties, all ad valorem property taxes and all sales and use taxes levied
- on and collected from the area in dispute between the counties shall be paid by the
- 16 <u>collecting county into an escrow account.</u> Such funds shall be held in such escrow account
- 17 <u>until a final resolution of the boundary line dispute. The funds shall then be paid to the</u>
- county in which the disputed property is determined to be located or as the counties
- involved in the dispute may mutually agree."
- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 22 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
