- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to surface mining, so as to revise maximum criminal penalties for
- 3 violations; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Part 3 of Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 7 relating to surface mining, is amended by revising Code Section 12-4-84, relating to criminal
- 8 penalties, as follows:
- 9 "12-4-84.

- Any person who engages in surface mining in violation of this part or who willfully
- misrepresents any fact in any matter required by this part or willfully gives false
- information in any application or report required by this part shall be guilty of a
- misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more
- than \$1,000.00 \$10,000.00 for each offense. Each day of noncompliance after notification
- shall be considered a separate offense."
