A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for a new charter for the City of Sandy Springs in Fulton County,  
2 approved April 15, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 3515), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
3 April 11, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 5359), so as to change the corporate boundaries of the city;  
4 to provide for related matters; to provide a contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting  
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act providing for a new charter for the City of Sandy Springs in Fulton County, approved  
9 April 15, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 3515), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 11,  
10 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 5359), is amended by designating the existing text of Section 1.02 as  
11 subsection (a) and by adding a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

12 "(b) In addition to all areas presently within the corporate boundaries of the City of Sandy  
13 Springs, the corporate boundaries shall include Fulton County tax parcels 17 0202 LL0340  
14 and 17 0202 LL0480 as such tax parcels existed on the tax rolls and tax maps of Fulton  
15 County for the year 2016."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which  
18 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, provided that an Act  
19 to deannex the territory described in this Act from the City of Atlanta is passed in the 2017  
20 regular session of the General Assembly and becomes effective on the same date.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
