A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to supplement the salaries of the judges of the Superior Court of Fulton
2 County, approved March 8, 1945 (Ga. L. 1945, p. 1076), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4092), so as to increase the amount of such
4 supplement for the judges of the superior court; to provide for related matters; to provide an
5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to supplement the salaries of the judges of the Superior Court of Fulton County,
9 approved March 8, 1945 (Ga. L. 1945, p. 1076), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
10 May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4092), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

11 "SECTION 1.

12 The Board of County Commissioners of Fulton County, or such other board or persons as
13 may from time to time exercise the administrative power of Fulton County, shall pay to
14 each of the judges of the Superior Court of Fulton County, in addition to the salaries paid
15 by the state, the sum of not less than \$49,748.00 per annum, payable in equal monthly
16 installments; provided, however, that the chief judge of the Superior Court of Fulton
17 County shall receive an additional county paid salary supplement in the sum of not less
18 than \$6,000.00 per annum, such amount to be paid in addition to the additional amount
19 paid by the county to each superior court judge and such amount also to be payable in equal
20 monthly installments. The board of county commissioners, or other board, is authorized
21 to increase the supplemental county salaries paid to the judges and chief judge of the
22 Superior Court of Fulton County. The amounts paid pursuant to this section are declared
23 to be part of the court expenses of said county."

24 **SECTION 2.**

25 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2014.

26 **SECTION 3.**

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
