March 27, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 205), so as to provide for the selection of the chief judge of

- 71 by a majority vote of the total number of active judges in such circuit by secret ballot.
- 72 Elections shall be held during the second week of August preceding the expiration of a term.
- A quorum for conducting such election shall be five active judges. In the event no person
- obtains a majority vote after three ballots, the chief judge shall be the eligible judge having
- 75 the most seniority. The term for a chief judge shall be two years beginning on January 1, and
- a person may be elected to successive terms. If a presiding chief judge resigns the position
- or the position otherwise becomes vacant, the next most senior judge shall assume the duties
- of the position for the remainder of the vacated term. The chief judge shall be vested with
- 79 the power to prepare schedules for conducting the circuit business for his or her term and
- 80 shall make all appointments whenever the law provides for the superior court judge to make
- 81 appointments."

- 84 (a) For purposes of making the initial appointments of the judges to fill the superior court
- judgeships created by Parts I and II of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon its
- approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

87 (b) For all other purposes, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
