## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide that future elections for the office of chief judge of the Magistrate Court of
- 2 Brooks County shall be nonpartisan elections; to provide for the sitting chief judge of the
- 3 magistrate court to serve out his or her term of office; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 All elections for the office of chief judge of the Magistrate Court of Brooks County
- 8 conducted after the effective date of this Act shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for
- 9 in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A. and shall be conducted at the nonpartisan general
- 10 election immediately preceding the expiration of each respective term of office. Such
- 11 nonpartisan elections shall be held and conducted as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the
- 12 O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."
- SECTION 2.
- 14 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the chief judge of the Magistrate Court
- of Brooks County in office on the effective date of this Act. The sitting chief judge of the
- 16 magistrate court shall serve out the term of office for which such chief judge was elected and
- shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as provided in this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3.
- 19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
