## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to social services, so
- 2 as to create the Legislative Gang Prevention and Intervention Commission; to provide for
- 3 membership; to provide for powers, duties, and objectives; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to social services, is amended
- 8 by adding a new chapter to read as follows:

## 9 "CHAPTER 11

- 10 49-11-1.
- 11 There is created the Legislative Gang Prevention and Intervention Commission. The
- 12 commission shall submit an annual report recommending strategic, coordinated, and
- 13 collaborative efforts between educational institutions and community and social services
- organizations for the implementation and maintenance of programs and initiatives designed

to prevent and intervene in criminal gang participation by youth. Such report shall be

- submitted to the House Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee and the Senate
- Public Safety Committee no later than January 1 of each calendar year.
- 18 49-11-2.
- 19 (a) The Legislative Gang Prevention and Intervention Commission shall consist of 14
- 20 members as follows:
- 21 (1) Two members who shall be appointed by the chairperson of the House Public Safety
- 22 <u>and Homeland Security Committee</u>;
- 23 (2) Two members who shall be appointed by the chairperson of the Senate Public Safety
- 24 Committee;
- 25 (3) A representative appointed by the Governor from the membership of the Georgia
- 26 Sheriffs' Association;
- 27 (4) A representative appointed by the Governor from the membership of the Georgia
- 28 Association of Chiefs of Police;
- 29 (5) A representative appointed by the Governor from the membership of the District
- 30 <u>Attorneys Association of Georgia;</u>
- 31 (6) A representative appointed by the Governor from the membership of the Georgia
- 32 <u>Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers;</u>
- 33 (7) Six members who shall be educators or representatives of the community or social
- 34 <u>service organizations with youth programs as follows:</u>
- 35 (A) Two members to be appointed by the Governor where one such member shall be
- 36 <u>designated by the Governor to serve as chairperson of the commission;</u>
- 37 (B) Two members to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and
- 38 (C) Two members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

39 (b) Members shall each be appointed for a term of two years and no member may serve

- 40 more than two consecutive terms. All vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by
- 41 <u>an appointee of the original appointing official.</u>
- 42 (c) The commission shall hold regular meetings at such times and such places as it may
- deem necessary or convenient, to accomplish the objectives and purposes of this chapter.
- 44 Special meetings may be called by the chairperson or a majority of the members of the
- 45 commission.
- 46 (d) A quorum for transacting business shall be determined by the members of the
- 47 <u>commission.</u>
- 48 (e) Members shall serve without compensation; provided, however, that any legislative
- member shall receive the allowances authorized by law for legislative members of interim
- 50 <u>legislative committees and any members who are state employees shall be reimbursed for</u>
- 51 expenses incurred by them in the same manner as they are reimbursed for expenses in their
- 52 <u>capacities as state employees.</u>

- 54 The Legislative Gang Prevention and Intervention Commission shall have the following
- 55 <u>objectives:</u>
- 56 (1) Submit an annual report recommending a plan for strategic, coordinated, and
- 57 <u>collaborative efforts between educational institutions and community and social services</u>
- 58 <u>organizations for the purpose of preventing and intervening in criminal gang participation</u>
- 59 <u>by youth; and</u>
- 60 (2) To provide informational resources, strategic guidance, research, and best practices
- 61 to social services and community organizations in the implementation of programs and
- 62 initiatives designed to prevent and intervene in criminal gang participation by youth."

## **SECTION 2.**

64 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
