A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to provide for the regulation of bows
- 3 and arrows by municipal corporations; to amend Chapter 35 of Title 36 of the Official Code
- 4 of Georgia Annotated, relating to home rule powers, so as to authorize municipalities to
- 5 regulate the use of bows and arrows; to provide for an exception; to provide for related
- 6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended in subsection (c) of Code Section 16-11-173,
- relating to legislative findings, preemption of local regulation and lawsuits, and exceptions,
- 12 by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 13 "(4) As provided for in Code Section 36-35-9, a municipal corporation may regulate the
- transport, carrying, or possession of bows and arrows."

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SECTION 2.

- 16 Chapter 35 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to home rule
- 17 powers, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 18 "<u>36-35-9.</u>
- 19 The governing authority of each municipal corporation shall have legislative power to
- 20 adopt clearly reasonable ordinances regulating the use of bows and arrows within the
- corporate limits of the municipality; provided, however, that private property owners or
- 22 persons in legal control of private property shall have the right to use or to allow for the use
- of bows and arrows on such private property consistent with state law, and no such
- 24 <u>ordinances shall restrict such right."</u>

25 SECTION 3.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
