## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to provide for the regulation of bows and arrows by municipal corporations; to amend Chapter 35 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to home rule powers, so as to authorize municipalities to regulate the use of bows and arrows; to provide for an exception; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## SECTION 1.

Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended in subsection (c) of Code Section 16-11-173, relating to legislative findings, preemption of local regulation and lawsuits, and exceptions, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
"(4) As provided for in Code Section 36-35-9, a municipal corporation may regulate the transport, carrying, or possession of bows and arrows."
