A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to provide that June 6 of each year shall be "Women's Golf
- 3 Day" in Georgia; to provide for legislative findings; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 8 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "1-4-24.
- 10 (a) The General Assembly finds that:
- 11 (1) The number of women playing and enjoying golf in Georgia is increasing at a rapid
- 12 pace;
- 13 (2) The popularity of golf among Georgia women is at an all-time high and still
- 14 <u>climbing</u>;
- 15 (3) According to the National Golf Foundation, 23 percent of all golfers are women; and

16 (4) It is now abundantly clear that the old adage that golf stands for 'Gentlemen Only,

- 17 <u>Ladies Forbidden' is no longer appropriate.</u>
- 18 (b) June 6 of each year is designated as 'Women's Golf Day' in Georgia."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
