A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 4 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
minimum wage law, so as to provide a minimum wage for certain state employees; to
provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1. 6 Chapter 4 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to minimum wage 7 law, is amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 34-4-3, relating to amount of 8 minimum wage to be paid by employers, as follows: 9 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in this Code section and in Code Section 34-4-3.2, every

10 employer, whether a person, firm, or corporation, shall pay to all covered employees a 11 minimum wage which shall be not less than \$5.15 per hour for each hour worked in the 12 employment of such employer."

SECTION 2.

14 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 15 "<u>34-4-3.2.</u>
- 16 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 17 (1) 'Eligible full-time state employee' means a full-time state employee who is paid on
- 18 <u>an hourly basis for actual hours worked.</u>
- 19 (2) 'Full-time state employee' means an individual who works at least 30 hours per week,
- 20 whose employment is intended to be continuing in nature, and who receives his or her
- 21 <u>compensation in a direct payment from a state agency.</u>
- 22 (3) 'State' means the State of Georgia.
- 23 (4) 'State agency' means any department, agency, commission, or other institution of the
- 24 <u>executive, judicial, or legislative branches of the government of the state</u>. Such term shall
- 25 not include the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.
- 26 (b) Beginning January 1, 2024, all eligible full-time state employees shall be paid a
- 27 <u>minimum wage of not less than \$15.00 an hour.</u>"
- 28 SECTION 3.
- 29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
