- 7 over other claims and superiority of security deed, is amended by revising subsection (a) as
- 8 follows:
- 9 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in Code Section 53-7-91 <u>53-7-40</u>, taxes shall be paid
- before any other debt, lien, or claim of any kind. The property returned, the property held
- at the time of returning property, and the property held after the time of returning property
- shall always be subject to a lien for taxes."
- 13 SECTION 2.
- 14 Code Section 49-1-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to home delivered
- 15 meals, transportation, services for the elderly, and preschool children with special needs
- 16 fund, is amended by replacing "Department of Community Health" with "Department of
- 17 Public Health" everywhere such term occurs.
- SECTION 3.
- 19 Code Section 49-5-132 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Governor's
- 20 Office for Children and Families, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 21 "(a) There is established the Governor's Office for Children and Families which shall be
- 22 assigned to the Office of Planning and Budget Department of Public Health for
- 23 administrative purposes."

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
