## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding torts, so as to give a right of action against any broadcaster who
- 3 broadcasts the depiction of an accident or trauma scene in such manner as would give
- 4 personally identifiable visual information or identification of a victim; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions regarding torts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>51-1-55.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 12 (1) 'Broadcast' means the transmission of video programming by an electronic or other
- 13 <u>signal conducted by airwaves or microwaves, by wires, lines, coaxial cables, wave guides</u>
- or fiber optics, by satellite transmissions directly or indirectly to viewers or listeners, or
- by any other means of communication.
- 16 (2) 'Broadcaster' means any corporation or other entity that is engaged in the business of
- broadcasting video programming, whether through the public airwaves, by cable, by
- direct or indirect satellite transmission, or by any other means of communication.
- 19 (b) Any broadcaster who broadcasts the depiction of an accident or trauma scene in such
- 20 manner as would give personally identifiable visual information or identification of a
- victim at such scene shall give the injured party a right of action."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
