## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 lottery for education, so as to provide that the Georgia Lottery Corporation shall offer one
- 3 or more games to benefit homeless military veterans; to provide a short title; to provide for
- 4 definitions; to provide for the deposit of proceeds into the general fund; to provide for a
- 5 special account to be appropriated for veterans' programs; to provide for purposes for which
- 6 appropriations shall be made; to provide for lapsing of funds; to provide for related matters;
- 7 to provide a conditional effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 8 for other purposes.

## 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 11 Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to lottery for
- 12 education, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

13 "ARTICLE 4

- 14 50-27-120.
- 15 This article shall be known and may be cited as the 'Georgia Lottery for Assistance of
- 16 <u>Homeless Military Veterans Act.'</u>
- 17 50-27-121.
- 18 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 19 (1) 'Account' means the lottery for assistance of homeless military veterans account.
- 20 (2) 'Veteran' means an individual who served on active duty in the armed forces of the
- United States or a state's National Guard and was honorably discharged from such
- 22 <u>service</u>.
- 23 (b) The corporation shall offer one or more lottery games for the benefit of Georgia
- 24 <u>homeless military veterans</u>. The lottery game or games shall commence on
- January 1, 2024, or as soon thereafter as is reasonably practical. The operation of the
- lottery game or games shall be governed by Article 1 of this chapter. If any provision of
- 27 this article is inconsistent with any other provision of this chapter, then this article shall
- 28 govern.
- 29 50-27-122.
- On or before the fifteenth day of each quarter, the corporation shall transfer to the general
- fund of the state treasury, for credit to the account for the preceding quarter, the amount of
- 32 all net proceeds during the preceding quarter from the lottery game or games for the benefit
- of Georgia veterans. Net proceeds shall be deposited in such account and separately
- overseen by the state treasurer by establishing and maintaining such account within the
- 35 state treasury.

- 36 <u>50-27-123.</u>
- 37 Upon their deposit into the state treasury, any moneys representing a deposit of net
- proceeds shall then become the unencumbered property of the State of Georgia, and the
- 39 <u>corporation shall have no power to agree or undertake otherwise. Such moneys shall be</u>
- 40 <u>invested by the state treasurer in accordance with state investment practices. All earnings</u>
- 41 <u>attributable to such investments shall likewise be the unencumbered property of the state</u>
- and shall accrue to the credit of the account.
- 43 50-27-124.
- 44 (a) In the budget report to the General Assembly, as a separate budget category entitled
- 45 'lottery for assistance of homeless military veterans proceeds,' the Governor shall estimate
- 46 the amount of net proceeds and treasury earnings thereon to be credited to the account
- 47 <u>during the fiscal year and the amount of unappropriated surplus estimated to be accrued in</u>
- 48 the account at the beginning of the fiscal year. The sum of estimated net proceeds, treasury
- 49 earnings thereon, and unappropriated surplus shall be designated 'lottery for assistance of
- 50 homeless military veterans proceeds.'
- 51 (b) In the budget report, the Governor shall further make specific recommendations as to
- 52 the programs and purposes for which appropriations should be made from the account. The
- General Assembly shall appropriate from such account by specific reference to it, or by
- reference to 'lottery for assistance of homeless military veterans proceeds.' All
- appropriations of lottery for assistance of homeless military veterans proceeds to any
- 56 particular budget unit shall be made together in a separate part entitled, identified,
- administered, and accounted for separately as a distinct budget unit for lottery for
- assistance of homeless military veterans proceeds. Such appropriations shall otherwise be
- made in the manner required by law for appropriations. Such appropriations shall be made
- for eliminating homelessness, preventing near-term homelessness, and providing safe and
- 61 <u>secure living conditions for homeless military veterans.</u>

- 62 <u>50-27-125.</u>
- 63 Appropriations for homeless military veterans' programs from the account not committed
- 64 <u>during the fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund and shall be credited to the account.</u>
- 65 50-27-126.
- Except as provided by this article, appropriations from the account shall be subject to Part 1
- of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget Act.'"
- 68 SECTION 2.
- 69 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023, only if an amendment to the
- 70 Constitution of Georgia is ratified at the time of the general election held in 2022 authorizing
- 71 the expenditure of lottery funds for the benefit of veterans' programs. Otherwise, this Act
- shall stand automatically repealed on December 31, 2022.
- 73 SECTION 3.
- All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
