## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 9-16-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to stay
- 2 of civil forfeiture proceedings during pendency of criminal proceedings, so as to require the
- 3 conclusion of criminal proceedings prior to civil forfeiture proceedings; to provide for an
- 4 exception; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 9-16-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to stay of civil
- 8 forfeiture proceedings during pendency of criminal proceedings, is amended by revising
- 9 subsections (a) and (b) as follows:
- 10 "(a) For good cause shown by the state or the owner or interest holder of the property, the
- 11 court may The court shall stay civil forfeiture proceedings during the pendency of criminal
- proceedings resulting from a related indictment or accusation until such time as the
- criminal proceedings result in a plea of guilty, a conviction after trial, or an acquittal after
- trial or are otherwise concluded before the trial court <u>unless the owner or interest holder</u>
- of the property waives such stay.
- 16 (b) An acquittal or dismissal in a criminal proceeding shall <del>not</del> preclude civil forfeiture
- 17 proceedings."
